

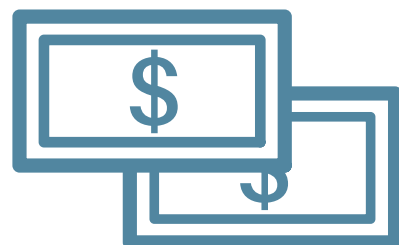


## COVID-19 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### CAN STUDENTS RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE ACCESS FUND MORE THAN ONCE?

Yes. Even if you have requested funding from the access fund before, they can help fund your travel home (depending on your fin aid package).



### SHOULD I STAY ON CAMPUS OR CAN I LEAVE AND COME BACK?

If you have the means and your home is safe, **YOU SHOULD LEAVE.** Please be realistic of the capacity of local facilities to handle an outbreak and be considerate of local residents.



### CAN STUDENTS TAKE A LOANER COMPUTER WITH THEM?

No they cannot, but they can apply to the access fund to buy a new one.



### WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU FILL OUT THE HOUSING SURVEY AND CHANGE YOUR MIND?

You can still leave. Please let Cornell Housing know if your plans change.
